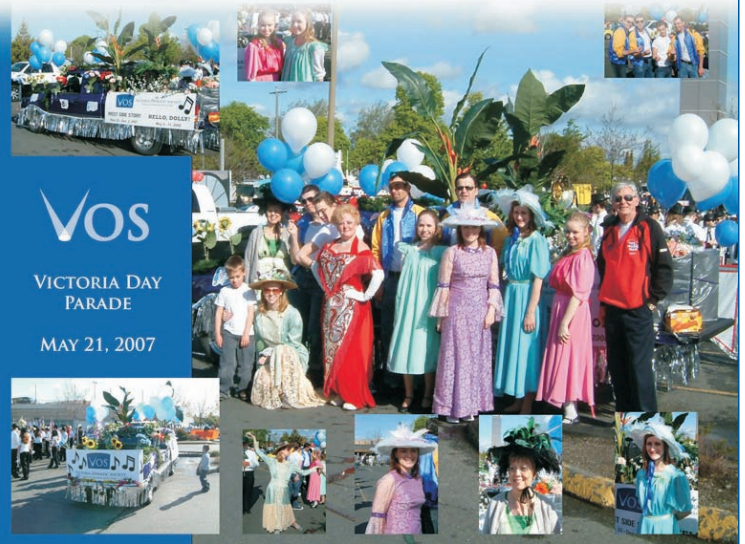
VOS is pleased to announce that we are participating in the Victoria Day Parade again this year!

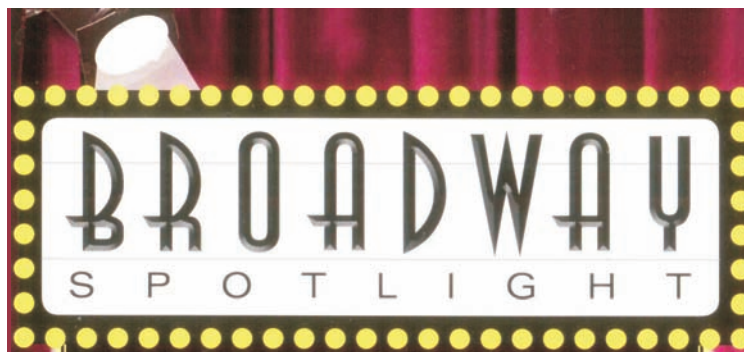

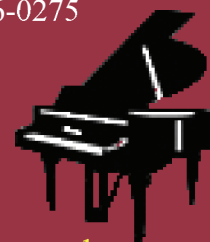
